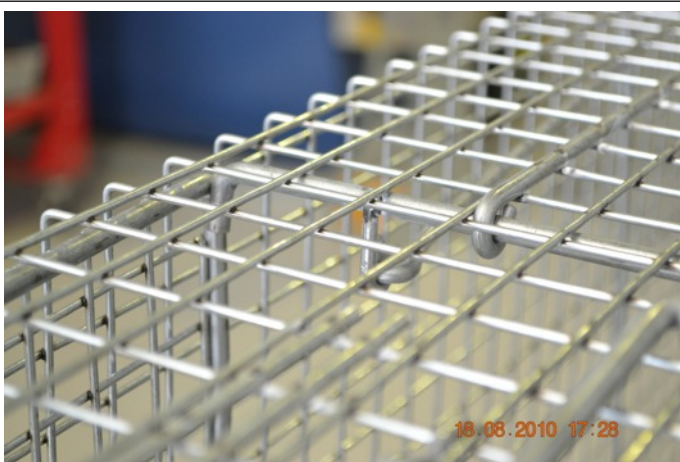
NEW ! FSD440 bat wing door, fox, turkey and small dog cage trap, unique door system avoids protruding door system as with other manufacturers traps and provides a lock system that eliminates animal escape. Size: 80cm long, 44cm high, 38cm wide, all galvanized parts.



While holding up door latch use hand to push inward both doors at same time past the latch



With the backs of both hands push both doors fully back and manouver double ended trigger bar in front of both doors, both doors must be held open at the same time.

Fox trapping

Cage trapping for foxes can be very successful if the correct procedures are followed, take short cuts and you will be wasting your time, money and patience.

If you are in a very remote rural area where there is no wire netting there is a very slim chance of enticing a fox in to a cage trap. Around homesteads and near civilization they are used to manmade fences and wire chicken compounds.

Place the trap where a fox is often seen, if only very occasionally use a fox lure to bring him to where the trap is located.

Bury some meat, chicken feet or similar and place the trap over the buried meat, the foot paddle should be located over the top where the meat has been buried, anchor the trap firmly with steel stakes or reinforcing steel bar, this is to prevent the fox from attempting to move the trap to get at the meat.

Set the trap doors open and either wire or cable tie both doors fully open. At dusk or when dark place small amounts of meat inside the trap and at the entrance, don't do in sunlight as Kookaburras, crows and other meat eating birds and day time animals will consume the bait.

Repeat the baiting for several days, rake around the trap to see if paw prints of a fox are evident.

After the fox has become used to the trap and bait is missing from inside the trap eventually set the trap ready for activation and remove any door restraints applied on the 1st day.

With luck and effort you have a fox
